

Looking Glass Youth & Family Services -- Donation Wishlist

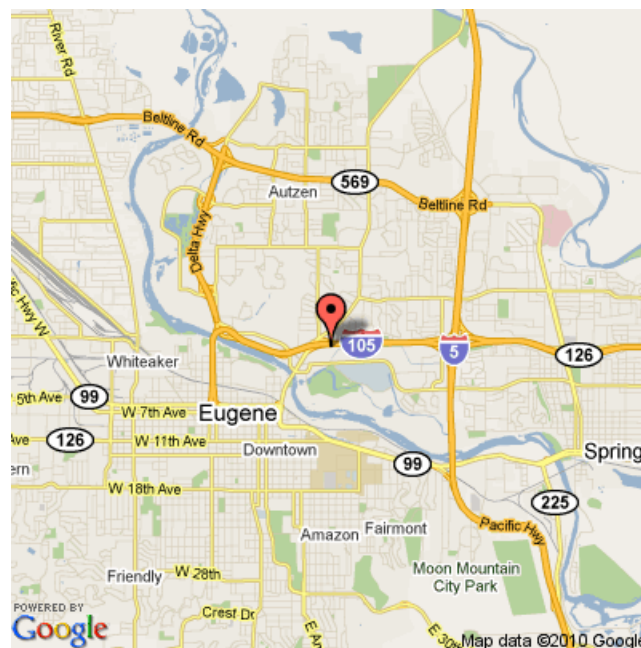
